Subject: Equitable Curtailment due to Hasting Extraction Plant outage

**IOGA WISHES TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO
INFORM YOU OF THE FOLLOWING OUTAGE AT THE
HASTINGS EXTRACTION PLANT AND THE
CORRESPONDING CURTAILMENT OF EQT DELIVERIES:**

Notice of Curtailment Order
August 24, 2009

Due to Dominion Transmission's (DTI) Hastings Extraction Plant outage, Equitrans must curtail deliveries off its gathering system to DTI, effective August 31, 2009 through September 3, 2009. As a result, all natural gas production on the Equitrans gathering system with receipt points that deliver to DTI via interconnects located on Lines H-1, H-10 and via Smithburg Compressor Station must be shut in commencing Saturday, August 29, 2009 at 5:00 p.m.

Additionally, as a result of DTI's Hastings Extraction Plant outage, it will be necessary to curtail natural gas production with receipt points that flow into the M-47 line between Underwood and Waynesburg Compressor Stations on Monday, August 31, 2009 at 7:00 a.m. To maintain system stability, Equitrans requests that producers/customers not curtail gas flows on the M-47 before 7:00 a.m. on August 31, 2009.

This Curtailment Order will extend through the completion of DTI's Hastings Extraction Plant outage which is scheduled for September 3, 2009 and Equitrans will notify customers/producers upon the termination of this order.

This Curtailment Order is issued pursuant to Sections 9.8 and 9.9 of the General Terms and Conditions (GT&C) of Equitrans' FERC Gas Tariff. Failure to comply with this curtailment order shall constitute unauthorized receipts and will be subject to a charge of \$25 / Dth in accordance with Section 9.9 of the GT&C of Equitrans' Tariff. Additionally, pursuant to Section 9.10 of the GT&C of Equitrans' Tariff, any producer/customer that fails to comply with this Curtailment Order shall be liable for any damages resulting from such failure to comply.

This notice is considered final notice of the curtailment on the above referenced lines/stations and no further time period to comply will be granted. Producers / Customers shall have the responsibility to inform its suppliers, transporters, and all others involved in the transaction as

to any curtailments or interruptions. Curtailment charges for unauthorized receipts, if any, will be billed to shipper invoices.

Equitrans will follow up with impacted shippers by sending a list of their specific meters that need shut in accordance with this curtailment order.

In response to a change in start and end dates, EQT must revise its Curtailment Notice as follows.

Shippers with receipt points that flow into the M-47 line between Underwood and Waynesburg Compressor Stations must shut in flowing production by 6:00 AM, Monday, August 31, 2009. Previous shut in time was 7:00 AM, Monday, August 31, 2009.

DTI has also extended its anticipated completion date to Friday, September 4, 2009 @ 7:00 AM. Previous completion date was Thursday, September 3, 2009 @ 7:00 AM.

All other provisions of the Curtailment Order remain unchanged.
